3.1. StuPa-Präsidium

3.1.1. Antrag Arbeitssprache und Pronomen-Redeliste des XXII. StuPa (Sabrina Arneth, DIE LINKE.SDS)

Antrag von Sabrina Arneth: Arbeitssprache (des Präsidiums) des 22. StuPa soll Englisch sein, bei Problemen sollte übersetzt werden.

(Application by Sabrina Arneth: The language used by the speakers is English, when problems occur they have to be translated.)

Matea Krolo (RCDS): Warum auf Englisch?

Dulguun Shirchinbal (BEAT!): There is a person, who only speaks english. Anyone who feels uncomfortable can switch.

Clara Baeumer (LHG): Aus Zeitgründen ggf. besser nur ins Englische übersetzen.

Luzie Freitag (TCY): Ich würde übersetzen.

Cedric Kortenbruck (RCDS): Vorschlag, direkt abzustimmen

Es gibt informelle Gegenrede.

Selina Syed (AStA): Shubham is an elected person who represents many international students. I understand that it will be difficult at first, but you should consider this.

Matea Krolo: Do you learn German?

Shubham Mamgain (TCY): No, not yet, my courses are in English.

Vivien Pejic (DIE LINKE.SDS): Translation of discussions will not always be possible on long term. They would also always be delayed for international students which would leave them no time and possibility to react take part in discussions properly. This would make decisions undemocratic and unfair. I suggest to write the protocol in used language and applications in both English and German.

Tobias Drauschke (DIE LINKE.SDS): Leute die nicht bereit sind, ggf. eine Stunde länger zu bleiben alle 3 Wochen, sind hier falsch.

3.1.2. Bericht Nil

Florian Rumprecht (FuckUP): I'm a Nil Member and deeply involved in the negotiations with the university and can report the current situation. Nil is closed since February, but there have been frequent meetings between Nil, Head of University, HGP (Janitors) and AStA to discuss and finally create a schedule for the reconstruction. There will be also some changes for the daily business, e.g. the Nil will be open during the day so that students can access the room freely to study. This is essential for the university because the available funds are dedicated to the topics "study and teaching" - which can be addressed this way.

Now there is a rough estimation of the costs from the university by 600.000€ and the university is taking the biggest part of it. We as the student side should be involved with 40.000€ to represent the usage of the space with cultural events at Nil in the evenings (which the university cannot support). That sum is already the result of negotiations and in the opinion of the Nil pretty fair. It wasn't clear whether the student side could spend 40.000€ in one go, so we suggested to split the payment to 20.000€ this year and the rest next year and the university agreed on that.

If everything goes smoothly, Nil should be reopened in winter next year. But this is just a short briefing and we can discuss all details in the next sessions.

Lukas Zechner (DIE LINKE.SDS): Nil might become creative space?

Florian Rumprecht: Nil has always been an open creative space for students and so it will be in the future, but there will be also a lot of changes because of the new utilization during the day.

Dulguun Shirchinbal: Could you provide the final concept and the estimation of costs for the next session? Otherwise it would be pointless to discuss the support in form of finances. And are the 2x 20.000€ already fixed?

Florian Rumprecht: We will provide any available information for the next session so that we can have a proper discussion. To the second question: Even the first 20.000€ are not guaranteed, because it is a parliamentary process and that is exactly what I told the University. But please consider that without dividing the costs the renovation of the Nil will halt and we would like to avoid that.

Dulguun Shirchinbal: Could you please explain the agreement process in detail next time?

Florian Rumprecht: Sure.

Matea Krolo (RCDS): Why are there 3 persons for AStA racism, and 1 for finances?

Tilman Kolbe (DIE LINKE.SDS): Because there is a lot of racism at our university. The statute of the students allows just one person for finances; it is just a suggestion.

Erkam Albayrak (Guest): I made the decision not to apply for AntiRa, but finances.

Shubham Mamgain: There should be more persons in the international department.

Jessica Obst (UP.rising): I'd like to request the following change: one additional person (2 persons) for SoPo, because our applicant wishes support. And +1 in Netzpolitik, too.

Tilman Kolbe accepts that request.

Lukas Zechner:@Shubham: The missing Referat für Internationales has just pragmatic reasons since there is no applicant yet.

Tilman Kolbe accepts Shubham Mamgain's suggestion.

Gerrit Herrmann (LHG): I propose to put one more person into finances.

Luzie Freitag: I agree with Gerrit.

Lukas Zechner: You'd have to change the statute to get more people into finances.

Matea Krolo: Application to put 1 AntiRa-Referent to BiPo.

Lisa-M. Maliga (AStA): Please don't increase the AStA too much, it will be hard to work together.

Angelo Camufingo (Guest): To have 3 persons in AntiRa just increases number of possibilities for AntiRa, there are many levels of racism that have to be tackled.

5.2. Vorstellung der Kandidat*innen – Introduction of Applicants

5.2.1. AntiRa

Angelo Camufingo: I am doing my master's degree in English to become a teacher. I am working on antiracism already, e.g. organising workshops. I am member of Black Lives Matter in Berlin and I want to form a university group in Potsdam.

Rasan Ali: I'm in the AStA since June, I am studying sociology. As far the work regarding the refugee teacher program went well. I want to establish a network with organisations in Brandenburg. We are also planning a room of silence. Sadly, the administration of the University has not understood the need of that yet.

About Ainhoa Davila: Started in June, too with the main topics antiracism and antisemitism and currently working for Antidiskriminierungsstabstelle at our university.

Theresa Hradilak (UP.rising): What exactly would Antidiskriminierungsstabstelle do?

Rasan Ali: It is not my project, but the main problem is that at the moment only it is unsalaried, an official place could achieve more.

5.2.2. Finanzreferat – Finances

Erkam Albayrak: I understand that the Finanzreferat has a huge responsibility and that there are many expectations on it. My goal is to support all students in Potsdam and set up projects for minorities, which we have the rare possibility to support directly.

Bahne Brand: I have lots of passion. I am not a status quo applicant. I want to achieve more transparency. I have enough time as I wrote in my application. I also have experience from school.

Tilman Kolbe: Are you in any political organisations or unions? Are the finances a political job?

Bahne Brand: No, I see myself as an independent candidate. Ich lege keine Rechenschaft für irgendeine Partei oder Ideologie ab nur vor euch, dem StuPa. The AStA is a political organ where every department is political. But the Finanzreferat is the least political.

Erkam Albayrak: I am not a member in a party, but i do voluntary work. I am a person for the political left wing. Finances is political, because you have a big responsibility for the money, and on the other hand not because it is not your main point. I think i should step back on my work an racism but work on finances.

Julian Baumann (UP.rising): What is your selling point, Erkam?

Erkam Albayrak: I don't know, we will see. But I am willing to learn.

Jasper Wiezorek (Juso HSG): What changed your mind to switch your application on such short term?

Erkam Albayrak: Rasan and I spoke about racism, I felt uneasiness in the air. We talked about it yesterday and it came up that we need someone for finances. So I am applying.

Theresa Hradilak: In supporting projects we have the problem of planning on long-term. Our proposal would be an update on the latest financial situation at every StuPa session.

Bahne Brand: It is my first priority. Transparency is very important, you as th StuPa have the right to know what happens.

Cedric Kortzenbrück: How would you make sure that nobody gets more money than they should at the AStA?

Erkam Albayrak: I have my backpack help of Tobias. These topics will be topic in this parliament.

Bahne Brand: Man muss sich an den Haushaltsplan halten, man muss zusammenarbeiten und Kompromisse schaffen; ich würde von Tobias gleiche Unterstützung erhalten.

Lukas Zechner: I reject the idea of the possibility to run away with money at AStA; it is great that we have an applicant with vision about Antiracism, intersectionalism and politics; this office is important because it is not just about crunching numbers but has a significant political impact.

Bahne Brand: Der Finanzreferent ist das am wenigsten politische Amt. Man kann nicht seinen Kopf durchsetzen. Wenn man jemanden hat, der eben noch das AntiRa-Referat machen wollte und jetzt plötzlich Financier werden will, der sollte diesen job nicht machen.

Gerrit Herrmann: I believe that in the past money has not been distributed well, how would you manage expense allowances?

Bahne Brand: Die Souveränität liegt beim Parlament.

Erkam Albayrak: Your question insinuates there is money missing, one could check this by reading the report.

Tilman Kolbe: What do you mean by "compensations are decided by StuPa, and distributed internally by AStA." Finances can not make these decisions anyways.

Bahne Brand: Es wäre nicht richtig, das Geld in bestimmte Richtungen zu schieben. Das kann zu Spannungen führen. I want to make everyone happy. Jeder soll zufrieden sein. Ich habe keine politische Vision.

Lukas Zechner: @Bahne: In your application you write that money of the student body should stay in Potsdam. This sounds like Anti-AStA-rhetorics and insinuates that money hasn't been distributed correctly in the past.

Bahne Brand: Mir geht es um die Anzahl der Studierenden, die von den Projekten direkt profitieren. Das sehe ich nicht so streng wie "Stadtgrenzen", oder dass ich etwas blockieren möchte. Meine Entscheidungen würden immer immer in Kooperation mit dem AStA stehen und ich arbeite für euch, euch hier heute im StuPa.

Erkam Albayrak: Was ist mit Projekten, die sich für Nicht-Studierende einsetzen?

Bahne Brand: Wenn es um Geflüchtete geht, bin ich gerne bereit, das zu unterstützen. Es sollten nur nicht zu viele Gelder außerhalb der Uni verwendet werden. Ganz wichtig ist für mich auch Investition in Öffentlichkeitsarbeit. Mehr Studis sollten die Projekte kennenlernen, um die Wahlbeteiligung letztlich zu steigern.

5.2.3. Geschlechterpolitik - Gender Policy

Doro König (AStA): I am working for the AStA since May of last year and sharing the gender-politics department. Main topics for me are supporting the [femarchiv] as an important space in potsdam with its work relating literature and events and where we also have employees. Furthermore I am

cooperating with the Gleichstellungsbüro. It is difficult to network with all groups, because oftentimes there are no permanent positions yet. I have to coordinate my work with many volunteers.

- About: She is part of the AStA for two years now. Therefore she has lots of knowledge and experience in the work which offers great possibilities.

5.2.4. Bildungspolitik - Education Policy

Philipp Okonek (AStA): I was member of AStA department for Campuspolitik. Now I am applying for Bildungspolitik. I have created a plan for the upcoming legislation in my written application.

5.2.5. Campuspolitik – Campus Policy

Selina Syed (AStA): I am in the AStA for two months now. My main work so far has been networking. I want to support all organs of our Uni to get to know each other well and strengthen their connections. My topics are free rooms: Lesecafe, VoKü. I am currently also involved in supporting international students because there is no official person in this department at AStA at the moment.

Jannis Göckede: I withdraw my application to Hochschulpolitik and now apply for Campuspolitik. I study PVO, have worked at university councils when I lived in Dortmund. My goals are the following: Improving communication with other students councils, fight for more affordable accomodation and offering emergency solutions if people don't find any accomodation.

5.2.6. HoPo

Jonathan Wiegers: I am in the Asta for 2 months now. A new situation in politics in Brandenburg has come up with the new coalition treaty. I want to make sure that a strong and independent student voice gets heard. Goals in the local area are more student's housing. The coalition treaty says 20 % of students have to get housing by studierendenwerk. At the moment only 9% are covered. I am taking part in working on the new university development plan: Students need to be involved in this. I also connect with BrandStuVe and FH and other AStAs in Brandenburg. Problems in Potsdam need more visibility and there are universities in a few cities that we can connect with.

5.2.7. Sozialpolitik - Social Policy

Michał Łuszczynski: I am in the AStA for two years. I want to go to Sozialpolitik. I want to promote offers of consulting for students with problems and improve them.

5.2.8. Presse/Öffentlichkeitsarbeit

Lisa-Marie Maliga (AStA): I want to continue taking care of our newsletter. In my final year I want to start a better documentation of knowledge and knowledge transfer in AStA, so that processes can become easier for everyone.

Gerrit Herrmann: Bist du dann auch verantwortlich für die AStA-Protokolle?

Lisa-Marie Maliga (AStA): Nein, habe ich zwar schonmal gemacht. Das ist aber grundsätzlich Aufgabe des gesamten AStA.

5.2.9. Kultur - Culture

Maximilian Mindl (AStA): Will connect with Ferdinand, want to organize an Unifestival with local bands, workshops, maybe also workshops for kids. We will work with KuZe, Nil etc.

Ferdinand Lamprecht (AStA): I have experience in KuZe department, for me Kulturpolitik would probably be more suitable, since I like organising events. All students can go to KuZe and take part in those events and workshops.

Tilman Kolbe: Florian Bell wrote that he changed his mind to go to antifascism. It does not exist in the AStA-structure at the moment, though. We could change the structure in the future and then elect him.

5.2.10. Umwelt und Verkehr – Ecology and Traffic

Richard Schwarz: I have worked in the department for ecology since last year. It is great that Hanna is there now, too. I have had difficult discussions with the StuWe about sustainable and healthy food at our mensa. Also, we founded the students for future.

Hanna Große Holtrup: I want more events on ecology. Uns ist es auch wichtig, vegane Ernährung an Studierende heranzubringen. Vegan nutrition should be brought to students.

5.2.11. KuZe

Tilman Kolbe: Ole isn't here. He is probably going to be here next time to introduce himself.

5.2.12. Sonstige Bewerbungen – Further Applications

Tilman Kolbe: Katja Schubel hat sich beworben (Antimil und Forschungsethik) aber ist nicht anwesend, daher sollte nochmals Rücksprache gehalten werden.

Theresa Hradilak: Vacant spots need to be publicly announced by the speakers.
